2. I will get permission from a parent or guardian every time I want to drive, and together we will plan my destination, route, passengers and an expected return time. 3. For my first ____ months with a license, I will drive only with an adult who is supervising my driving. When I've had my license for months, I will drive only with a supervising adult and immediate family members. I will drive only with _____ teen passengers once I've had my license for _____. 4. I will always wear a seat belt, as a driver or passenger. When I'm allowed to have passengers, I will only drive when everyone is 5. I will obey speed limits, stop signs, traffic signals, and the rules of the road. I'll reduce my speed when road conditions require it (i.e., inclement weather, darkness, sharp turns, congestion, unfamiliar roads). 6. I will not use my cell phone while driving. Before I begin to drive, I will stow my phone safely out of reach. I will pull over in a safe location if I need to use it. 7. I will drive only between the hours of _____ and _____, except in the event of an emergency. 8. I will never drive under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs or when I'm too tired to drive safely. I'll also never get into a car with a driver who is impaired from alcohol, drugs and/or lack of sleep. 9. I may call a parent or guardian for a safe ride home to avoid a dangerous situation and without my driving privileges suspended, at any time for any reason. IF I VIOLATE ANY OF THESE RULES, MY DRIVING PRIVILEGES WILL BE SUSPENDED FOR _____ DAYS. PARENT / GUARDIAN AGREEMENT 1. I will teach safe driving habits by being a responsible driver and a role model at all times. 2. I will provide my teen far more on-the-road training hours than state law requires because a graduate of driver's ed is a beginner, not a safe experienced driver. 3.
